A caregiver **MUST** attend with a camper.

Each camper is limited to ONE caregiver unless other arrangements have been made with Kelly (kelly@camphehoha.com)

Caregiver duties will include: providing personal care (feeding, toileting, etc), providing behavioural assistance, supervision, transitioning the camper from one activity to another, etc.

What you need to know . . .

Payment:

- FREE of charge.
- Donations appreciated.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

- Please notify kelly@camphehoha.com as soon as a cancelation requirement is determined so that we may offer your spot to a waitlisted camper.
- Transportation fees (if applicable) will be non-refundable.

Medical Form

A medical form is **NOT** required for camper attendance to Day Camp programs. We expect that any medical care (including medication administration) is completed by the attending caregiver.

We will have a 3rd year nurse on site for our Day Camp programs to provide any assistance that you may need.

Camper Screening

Camp Health, Hope & Happiness reserves the right to terminate a camper's attendance to camp due to contagious illness (ie: flu, cold, chicken pox etc.) or other communicable concerns (ie: head lice, etc.)

Transportation

Bus transportation may be available depending on interest indicated in registration.

We know that transportation out to camp may be a significant barrier to some campers attending the day camp programs so we will work hard to find a solution that will also consider expense. Transportation, if available, will be confirmed with each registered camper at a later date.

If busing is provided, we will be using TELUS World of Science Centre (11211 142nd Street) parking lot for pick up and drop off. Please use only the 111th Avenue entrance and South end of the parking lot. TELUS World of Science Centre donates the South end of the parking lot to us for use and we do not want to impede on their business.

Start of Camp

BUS TRANSPORTATION:

Any campers that have received confirmation of busing available will receive more information about check-in time at a later date.

PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION:

Please arrive at **Camp He Ho Ha** and be ready for activities starting at **9:30am for check-in.** It will be difficult to incorporate late arrivals, so please be on-time. If you arrive early, our staff will not be able to assist until **9:30am**.

End of Camp

BUS TRANSPORTATION:

The bus (if available) will return the campers to the TELUS World of Science Centre, departing Camp He Ho Ha at **4:30pm.**

PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION:

Please be prepared to depart from Camp He Ho Ha at **4:30-5:00pm.**

Preparing for camp:

The following items will need to be presented at Check-In. Please ensure that they are each labelled with the camper's full name.

Special Diets:

Please indicate all dietary concerns and requirements for campers and caregivers within the registration so that we may plan substitute items as necessary.

Tuck money:

We recommend approximately \$25.00 for tuck money. This allows the camper to purchase 1-2 souvenirs and/or have a few dollars for treats.

2023 Camp T-shirs are NOT available.

Medications/Medical Supplies:

It is necessary that each camper arrive at Camp with ALL necessary prescriptions, medication / apparatus and / or appliances that they will need for their camp day.

<u>Diabetes:</u> Campers with diabetes must bring insulin, syringe, needles and glucometer/testing strips.

<u>Allergic Reactions</u>: If the camper is anaphylactic, they must bring an **Epi-pen**, or whatever may be necessary. Check with the physician.

<u>Personal Drugs:</u> Camp Health, Hope & Happiness is **NOT** responsible for supplying or paying for prescription drugs or "as required/PRN" drugs required by campers. Please bring any Advil, Benadryl, AfterBite, etc. that you may need.

<u>Ileostomy Bags & Catheters:</u> Campers must come with adequate supplies for the camp period; (ie: cement, solvent, etc.)

<u>Incontinence:</u> Campers need to bring a sufficient number of attends/liners or catheter supplies. We encourage hydration so we recommend bringing extra as well.

<u>Important Note:</u> You may bring your own personal snacks/drinks. These CANNOT be shared with other campers without express permission from their caregiver. Due to the severity of many <u>peanut allergies</u> we ask that you do NOT bring any products, or food that contains peanuts, nut oils, or traces of nuts.

Please **label <u>ALL</u>** camper items with masking tape or non-water-soluble laundry pen, including their first and last name

Packing for Camp:

Suggested Items

- Jacket/Sweater
- Raincoat/Umbrella
- Close-toed shoes (for safety in <u>some</u> camp activities.
 May wear open-toed shoes for other activities.)
- Hat
- Bathing Suit
- Towel
- Change of clothes (in case soiled, wet, or weather inappropriate)
- Extra briefs and socks
- Medications
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Tuck Money
- Water bottle (provided complimentary by Camp)

Mobility Assistive Devices:

Remember any trays, or attachments required Camp is very large in area and requires a lot of travel distance between locations, please bring wheelchairs, walkers, canes, etc that will assist the camper or cargiver

Specialized Equipment:

Specialized utensils, plate guards, etc.

<u>Electronics</u>: We discourage the use of electronics unless they are used as a Camper communication device.
