Dear Friend of Camp,

Camp Health, Hope & Happiness provides week-long adapted summer camps to people of all ages living with all types and degrees of disabilities. Our facility, located 90 kilometers west of Edmonton on Lake Isle, is fully modern and barrier-free. Each year, more than 600 Albertans with disabilities, ranging in age from 6 to 105, come from communities small and large across the province to experience our recreational summer camp programs in a safe and supportive environment.

Many people with disabilities and their families face significant financial barriers that can prevent access to meaningful adapted programming. As such, **Camp He Ho Ha subsidizes the fee for every camper by 50 per cent of the actual costs.** Although this is a difficult business model to sustain, we recognize that without the subsidy many campers would be unable to attend.

Annually in May, we host the Shoot for Cause archery tournament to raise funds in support of our summer camp programs. Archers from across the province collect pledges and compete on a course of 60 targets. This is our largest and most successful fundraiser, bringing in more than \$100,000 each year.
