For more than 60 years Camp Health, Hope & Happiness has been Alberta's leading summer recreational facility, providing unforgettable camp experiences for individuals of all ages with physical, developmental, and neurodiverse disabilities.

Our 2026 camp season features Monday-Friday, (5-day, 4-night) camps, beginning with a 9-day orientation week starting **May 21st**. The season concludes with a summer staff wrap-up celebration on **August 23rd**.

PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

Reporting to the Camp Coordinator, the **Resource Lead** will create themes and camp wide activities throughout the week to create an inclusive and fun environment for everyone at camp. The resource lead will play a key role in creating an inclusive environment where all campers feel values and accepted during their time at camp. The resource lead will be on-site for 24rs a day while campers are present, providing continuous support and guidance throughout their camp experience.

WHAT YOUR DAY WILL LOOK LIKE

- You will plan, lead and facilitate all camp wide activities, providing direction to teams and campers throughout the activities. This includes both indoor and outdoor activities in varying weather conditions.
- Complete registration on Day 1 when campers arrive, working alongside the nurses to ensure that all meds and forms are organized based on cabin

- Provide campers with emotional support to encourage a positive outlook, while building and maintaining strong relationships
- Assist in the cabins when needed, following the role of a camp counselor
- Participate and encourage camper participation at all camp activities, always engaging with campers whether they participate or not
- Assist with tasks from the Camp Coordinator. i.e. taking photos, supporting in the cabin, getting the evening snack, etc.
- Participate in Friday reset for the upcoming week, cleaning, cabin preparation, and activity planning

This may be one of the most rewarding and challenging roles you ever experience. The days are long, but the connections you form, both with campers and fellow peer, will stay with you for years. Your heart will grow in ways you never expected.

QUALIFICATIONS

- No experience needed — just a willingness to learn! Our summer program does align with students in educations streams such as psychology, sports studies, nursing, social work, education, or similar programs.
- Enthusiasm for camp, creativity, and making each day fun and meaningful
- Current Standard First Aid and Level C CPR certification valid for the entire work term (support available if not currently certified)
- Clear Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check
- Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to work collaboratively as part of a team
- Strong organizational skills with the ability to independently set priorities
- Ability to provide personal care, support behavior management, and lead activities
- Responsible, reliable, and adaptable in a fast-paced environment
- Demonstrates empathy, patience, and a caring attitude
- Eager to jump in, be silly, dress up, and take part in camp fun such as going into the dunk tank
