EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE CAMP



PAYMENT

- Payment can be made by VISA, Mastercard, Debit VISA, or prepaid credit card by logging into your **UltraCamp** account.
- If a public trustee handles the camper finances, please ensure they have submitted confirmation of the deposit funds by email to **bobbi@camphehoha.com**, to ensure that the funds are appropriately allocated to the camper's account.
- Camp fees must be paid at least **4 weeks prior** to the first day of the registered camp. Our system will automatically withdraw the remaining balance from the credit card on file, if we do not receive the balance by this due date.
Personal Cheque or money orders will be accepted E-transfers can be made to: **bobbi@camphehoha.com** if a credit card is not available. You must include the campers name & charges your paying for.

(Ex. John Smith, Camper Fee \$700, Tuck \$50, Transportation \$50)

REFUND / CANCELLATION POLICY

At Camp He Ho Ha, we understand that plan can change. Please review our refund policy carefully:

- Cancellations 7 days or more before camp starts: Full refund, no fees.
- Cancellation less than 7 days before camp starts: A \$100 cancellation fee will be charged, and the remaining amount will be refunded.
- No show or leaving on Day 1: 50% refund of camp fee.
- Leaving anytime after Day 2: No refund available.

Please notify us as soon as possible, if you need to cancel or make changes to your registration.

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW: **MEDICAL**

MEDICAL FORM

Medical forms are only required once every 3 years.

- If you submitted a medical form in **2024** or **2025**, a new form is **not required** at this time.
- All required medical forms can be found in the '**Document Center**' on **UltraCamp**. Please ensure both the **Medical Form** and **MAR** are completed and submitted **at least two weeks prior to the first day of camp**.
- **Registration without a completed medical form on the file will be cancelled**, as we are unable to safely support campers without this information.



The Medical Form and MAR are due 2 weeks prior to the first day of the registered camp.



NEED TO KNOW: TRANSPORTATION



BUS TRANSPORTATION

- **The bus transportation fee is now \$25 per direction of travel.**
- If bussing is required, payment and confirmation of transportation must be added to the campers profile **no less than 3 weeks** before the start of camp.
- Any cancellation of transportation is non-refundable within 3 weeks of their scheduled camp start date.

★ If the registration for bussing has not been completed at least 21 days prior to the first day of the registered camp, the camper will be denied transportation from Cineplex Odeon Theatre. ★

★ We will not accept payment at the time of bus check-in. ★

FIRST DAY OF CAMP

BUS TRANSPORTATION

- Please be at the **North Edmonton Cineplex Odeon Theatre** on the **first day of camp at 9:30 am**.
- The bus will **LEAVE** at 10:00 am.
- Any campers who miss the bus will have to arrange for alternate means of transportation.

PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION

- If campers are arriving at camp via their own arranged private transportation, please plan on arriving at Camp He Ho Ha **between 10:30 - 11:00 am**.

LAST DAY OF CAMP

BUS TRANSPORTATION

- The bus will return campers on the last day of camp to the North Edmonton Cineplex Odeon Theatre at **12 pm** for all camps.

DATS

- For campers travelling by DATS, we recommend pick-up be scheduled for **12 pm or later**, in the event that the bus experiences some delays.
- Camp He Ho Ha is no longer responsible for the camper upon arrival to the bus drop-off location. If the camper requires assistance to meet DATS, please ensure someone is at the bus station to assist them.

PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION

- Please plan for departure at **10:00 am** for all camps

There is a \$150.00 FEE for any camper pick-up
that is more than 30 minutes late.
ie: 10:30 am at Camp or 12:30 pm at Cineplex



NEED TO KNOW: PREPARING FOR CAMP



The following items need to be presented at check-in:

- MEDICATIONS
- CAMPER PROFILE
- TUCK MONEY



Please ensure that they are each labelled
with the camper's full name.



MUST-HAVE ITEMS

MEDICATIONS/ MEDICAL SUPPLIES

- It is necessary that each camper arrive at camp with **ALL** required prescriptions, medication/apparatus & or appliances. Please check with your physician that all prescriptions are renewed, filled & sufficient to last the total time at Camp.
- **All medications must be pre-packaged in dosettes or bubble packs from the pharmacist.**
- Do not send prescriptions in bottles or small envelopes. This allows the nursing staff to administer medications with minimal complications and less risk of error.

CAMPER PROFILE

- This form is to be completed the day before the camper arrives at camp.
- Please describe in detail the best method of personal care for this camper & explain how much the camper can do on their own. This form is used to catch any changes that happen between when the medical form was completed & when the camper arrives on site.

TUCK MONEY

- We recommend approximately \$50 for the week. This allows the camper to purchase 1-2 souvenirs as well as have a few dollars each day for snacks. The cost of a T-shirt is \$20.

MEDICATIONS & EQUIPMENT

- **Allergies:** If the camper is anaphylactic, they must bring an Epi-pen, or whatever else is necessary. Check with physician.
- **CPAP Machines:** Campers requiring CPAP machines must bring their own machine & distilled water for it.
- **Diabetes:** Campers with diabetes must bring insulin, syringes, needles & glucometer/testing strips. Please ensure instructions are clear on the application form & camper profile.
- **Personal Drugs:** Camp He Ho Ha is NOT responsible for supplying or paying for prescription drugs required by campers.
- **Ileostomy Bags & Catheters:** Campers must come with adequate supplies for the camp period (ex. cement, solvent etc.).
- **Incontinence:** Campers need to bring sufficient number of attends/liners for their stay. Please detail typical daily use. We encourage hydration, so we recommend sending extra.

SPECIAL DIETS

- At camp we do our best to accommodate all of our campers/aides special diets.
- It is necessary that camp is aware of any special diets of campers/aides prior to their arrival so we are able to meet their needs.
- Please indicate all dietary concerns & requirements within the registration, medical form & camper profile,
- **If there is a dietary change between registration completion & attendance at Camp, please let us know as soon as possible.**



Due to severe peanut allergies, we ask that you do not bring any products of foods that contain peanuts, nut oils, or traces of nuts



EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW: **PACKING**



Please label all camper luggage with
masking tape in the following format:

PACKING

CLOTHING LIST

- Please fill out the Camp He Ho Ha clothing list completely & place it in the camper's luggage for drop off at the bus or camp. Camp staff will ask that the clothing list remains in the luggage until arrival in the assigned cabin.

LAUNDRY

- Laundry services are not provided to campers. Please ensure that campers come with adequate clothing for the duration of their stay. Adequate, basic clothing is essential, as activity level is high and clothes are changed daily, to maintain proper hygiene. If you have questions about this, please call the summer camp coordinator.

ELECTRONICS

- If avoidable, please do not send electronics to camp. We discourage the use of electronics unless they are required by a camper as a means of communication with staff or other campers.
- Camp He Ho Ha is not responsible for any long distance calls & prefers that campers not use phones.
- If you would like to be in contact with your camper during their stay, please discuss this with the Summer Camp Coordinator.

CAMP IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST ITEMS

NEED TO KNOW: DURING THE STAY



VISITING

- We do not allow visitations during camps, unless of an emergency, as visitations can be very disruptive to the camper and cabin.
- This ensures that the camper has every opportunity to make the most of their experience at Camp.
- If an emergency arises, please contact the Summer Camp Coordinator.

FSCD

- A camp letter verifying a child's attendance to Camp He Ho Ha will be provided for all children (18 yrs & under) whose registration indicates the intention to apply for social assistance with Family Support for Children with Disabilities (FSCD). Please ensure the registration form indicates this correctly so that you receive a letter at the end of their camp stay.
